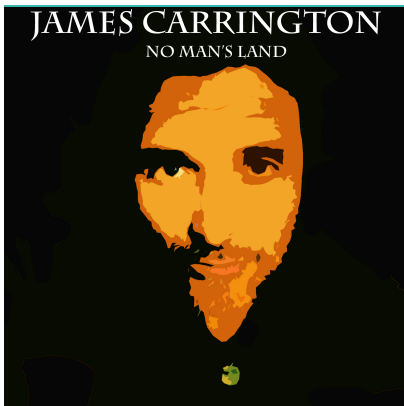

JAMES CARRINGTON TO RELEASE NEW ALBUM

LOS ANGELES, CA. October 6, 2016: Red Limpit Productions announced today that the long-awaited album from British singer/songwriter James Carrington is being released on October 18, 2016. The public is invited to a live performance of the entire work entitled "No Man's Land" which includes the following songs: Wanted, Map of Us, Windows, Ache (Demo version), Unwind, Texas girl at the funeral of her father, Turn Back, Lost and Found, Hymn to Her, Flying, When This Was Home, Tell Me and the album's title cut, No Man's Land.

Carrington is perhaps best known for his song "Ache" which is described by music supervisor Madonna Wade-Reed as "one of those songs that captures the depth of the sadness that grips someone's heart when they've lost someone they love. When it was used on 'Smallville' it resonated like no other song we had used. The ripple effect was undeniable as the episode aired around the world." This song has been also featured on many other shows, including "ER", "The Vampire Diaries" and the long running ABC daytime soap "One Life to Live". YouTube presently hosts more than 80 cover versions and tribute videos of the song.

Described by Grammy award-winning producer/engineer James Guthrie (Pink Floyd and Kate Bush) as "one of the best singer/songwriters I've had the privilege to work with," Carrington is a gifted guitarist, pianist and singer. He performs on every song on this album, and is joined by many well-known players and collaborators, such as Martin Briley, Jackson Dimiglio-Wood, Paul Freeman, David Franz, Ian Honeyman, Julianna Raye, Joey Silvestri, Jesse String, John Trivers and Jake Gosling, who was twice nominated for a Grammy for his work with Ed Sheeran on multi-million selling albums "+" and "X" and for the single "Thinking out Loud." Gosling co-wrote and produced "Map of Us" with Carrington and Paul Freeman and produced two other songs on the record. Production on this album spans a wide timescale of sessions both in the US and in London, and represents a veritable anthology of Carrington's songwriting work between 2001 and 2016.
